This report is an opportunity to share the great work you accomplished with your 2025 BGV funding as you look ahead to next year. If you have incomplete activities happening after October 1, please reach out to a member of our team to request an extension.

To access your report, follow these steps:

- 1. Login to your account on the BGV Grants Portal.
- 2. Navigate to *Grantee Reports* Section on the left-hand side.
- 3. Select Reports Due (1).
- 4. Select *Edit* in the top right corner.
- 5. Complete your impact report and hit *submit*!


