





12 MONTHS OF BGV GIV(ES)ING

What a year for **BGV Gives**! Over the past twelve months, we've doubled down on BGV's **triple bottom line commitment to people, planet, and prosperity**. In partnership with our incredible nonprofit and community partners, here are 12 moments of impact from 2025:



1. Donated more than 122 snowboards and ski jackets to participants of [Oso Outdoors](#) and [SOS Outreach](#).



2. Installed advanced ice melt systems, pool covers, lighting upgrades, and solar arrays at the [Breck Inn](#)—all working to reduce our greenhouse gas emissions by 24% since 2019.



3. Completed 4,200 Electric Vehicle charging sessions through charging stations at BGV properties, compared to 3,900 last year.



4. BGV employees attended over 2,400 local events and experiences through BGV's ticket program, in partnership with the [Breckenridge Backstage](#) and [Eclipse Theaters](#), and the [Breck Vipers](#).



5. Added 10 composters at BGV properties, supporting a 34% waste diversion rate in 2025 and keeping 1,400+ pounds of waste out of our landfill. This is a could fill a pickup truck with composted food waste!




6. Raised more than \$3,000 for local nonprofit partners through Toast Round Up on Point of Sale (POS) systems at BGV properties.




7. Mobilized over 230 volunteers across 11 locations during [RAM Legacy in Action Day](#)—contributing 700+ volunteer hours in a single day.




8. Transitioned to 100% paperless contracts in BGV's contracts department, saving more than 79,000 pieces of paper annually.



9. Partnered with [High Country Conservation Center](#) (HC3) to provide bilingual recycling training for 92 employees.



10. BGV employees logged 7,763 miles of green commuting, reducing emissions and promoting sustainable transportation, during our Annual Green Commute Challenge.



11. Brought holiday cheer by purchasing and delivering gifts to 29 families (100+ people!) in partnership with [Mountain Mentors](#) through BGV's Annual Adopt-a-Family program.



12. As of mid-December, BGV employees contributed more than 9,000 hours of volunteer time in Summit and Park Counties.


CELEBRATING 50 YEARS!




[Keystone Science School](#)
